Presídent's Message:

This year we are marking the milestone of the 70th Anniversary of our Bath Branch. Our Branch in the Southern Tier of NYS is one of thousands of branches on our AAUW National Mother Tree, 142 years young!

We know from handwritten notes, stored in our archives, that initial organizational meetings were held in the fall of 1952. A small group of women from our local communities banded together to pursue the establishment of a Bath Branch with Barbara Stewart acting as chair for the first meeting and Joyce Benesh selected as temporary chairwoman thereafter.

The notes show our founding mothers consulting with NYS AAUW regarding the writing of by-laws, forming a nominating committee, a program committee, and recruiting members who were asked to fill out forms and state the name of their college or university and year of graduation. A newspaper clipping in our holdings records that a few of those women accepted an invitation to meet with the Corning AAUW Branch to further their understanding about the functions of a local branch. Approval from the State and National AAUW offices apparently came through in 1953, thus that being our formation year.

Election of officers was held in April,1953, with Barbara Stewart, formally known as Mrs. James Stewart elected as our first president. Our copy of the 1954-1955 Program & Membership Directory records the names of 41 members from the Avoca, the Canisteo, Bath and Hammondsport areas! I can imagine how rewarding this undertaking was for our founding officers and members.

We enjoyed a champagne toast at our scholarship dinner and celebration on June 6th! Thank you to Marianne Furfure for providing the champagne for our Platinum Jubilee!

Thank you to members who purchased Gary Brown's latest book. In Gary's words, thank you for supporting the work of two caring, hospice-related agencies in the area by making a suggested donation of \$15.00. Gary is still very grateful for the way hospice taught and supported and encouraged the Brown family in the final weeks of Martha's life.
